Chairman's announcements

Cllr G Carter gave a brief overview of the Councils activity during the past 12 months. The slide has been renovated at Hilgay play area and new play area equipment has been funded for Ten Mile Bank.

The entrance to River field is an ongoing issue and the Council along with FEOFFEES are continuing to ensure that this area is safeguarded for the future.

Public comments and discussion

A member of public discussed their planning application for a replacement garage at Manby Close.

A request was made by Mr Barrington for notice boards to be placed on the outside of the bus shelters.

The Council were asked if they would consider making a donation towards the purchase of a defibrillator for Hilgay. So far £812.00 has been raised; the cost of a defibrillator is around £1500.00 - £1700.00. A training session will be held if a defibrillator is purchased.

It was reported that Hilgay village hall is doing well and the cinema clubs have thus far been very successful.

The council will discuss contributing a donation towards the defibrillator fund at the next meeting of the Council.
