














Young Goob, 16 years old, returns home to his mother in the countryside, between a small restaurant and a field of pumpkins. It's a long hot summer in rural Norfolk and a rough coming of age for Goob, as he contends with his mother's new boyfriend, the brutal, womanising Gene Womack.

Set in the unvamished working countryside rarely seen in films, or by visitors to Norfolk, the film's depiction of a rural underclass is convincing because it's situated in real places with real people, including a determination to find actors who could master the Norfolk accent. Liam Walpole was cast after being spotted by the casting agent in his home town of Dereham, two local builders were given roles, a local stock car racer performed the main stunt, and the pickers were real migrant workers using their own hi-vis jackets.

News from Hilgay Methodist Church

A Deacon for Hilgay

From September 1st 2016, the West Norfolk Circuit of the Methodist Church will receive a full time Deacon to take up ministry primarily in Hilgay, together with some time in Downham Market.

Deacon Irene Tafirenyika has been appointed. She has been working in Bradford for the past 5 years. It had been hoped that not only would Deacon Irene work in Hilgay but, with her family, would also live in the village. Sadly this hasn't been possible as the Church has not been able to find suitable housing in Hilgay and so they will live in Downham Market.

Deacon Irene's brief as a Methodist Minister in the village will be to build upon some of the work already happening at the Chapel and we hope she will also come with fresh ideas. She will be offering pastoral care to all ages and will be especially available to families with children.

A Methodist Deacon is an ordained minister, whose main function is to look out into the community and to show the love of Jesus and the Church in acts of service and care. A deacon is also called a "minister" and is a member of a dispersed religious order of men and women, who seek to live by a Rule of Life. Being a deacon in the Methodist Church is a permanent, lifelong commitment to servant ministry.

We will be welcoming Deacon Irene at a special service at the Methodist Chapel early in September and when further details are known we hope that many folk from Hilgay will come along and meet her.
