A meeting was held in Hilgay Village Hall on Tuesday 14th November to talk about Crime Prevention. Sargent Hemeter and P.C. Smith from Downham Market Police Station attended along with 48 members of the public.

The police talked to the audience about recent crime and assured them that compared to a lot of villages, Hilgay has a low crime rate with no new reports of burglary reported last month. In the last two months there have been 25 calls for police to come to Hilgay consisting of alcohol, mental health, firework and road parking related issues.

However, there have been some burglaries this year and the police advised us on various ways to protect our property.

They took questions from the audience and left us with leaflets and stickers and a re-assurance that all reported crime would be followed up.

People who were interested in starting up a "Neighbourhood Watch" scheme left their email addresses and will be having another meeting later to hopefully set this up.
