

We are still looking for a cleaner, twice a month. If you are interested please give Kathy or Peter Hudson a call on 01366 385578 for more information.





A wonderfully chaotic Palm Sunday service was held in April, attended by over 50 villagers, including 18 children and one amazingly contented baby! The children were able to move freely between their parents/carers and the craft supplies at the back of the Church, with Fr Alan awarding a prize for the best craft item (pictured below). Incredibly, after the service, not only were all the 2019 Easter eggs found, but the children even managed to find eggs from 2018 and 2017 (pictured below)! Unsurprisingly no one wanted to take these home.





Christian Aid Week commenced on Sunday 12th May, with a service in St Mark's. This service of quiet prayer and contemplation was held on a beautiful spring evening, with the door wide open, the late sun streaming through the windows and the sound of birds outside in the trees. An assortment of Mary's cakes accompanied the teas and coffees afterwards, with a selection of cakes available for purchase.

As a result of the number of children trying to access the craft table at Easter, we realised that we needed more space at the back of the Church. Furniture has been moved and a much larger space is now available for the children. We plan to have another craft table at both the Lavender service (currently planned for July) and at our Harvest service at the end of September. After these, we will consider whether yet more space should be made available to the children. We are still in discussion about the Lavender service, but we are hoping to have a "celebration of summer" service, with Lavender products for sale in the Church.

Riverside News Parish Past and Present A Look at Local History

CAPTAIN MANBY – LOCAL HERO


Part 1 – The Man

The next time you visit All Saint's Church in Hilgay, take a look up at the right-hand wall and you will see a stone engraved as follows:

IN THE CHURCHYARD NEAR THIS SPOT REST THE BONES OF GEORGE WILLIAM MANBY CAPT-F.R.S. A NAME TO BE REMEMBERED AS LONG AS THERE CAN BE A STRANDED SHIP. HE DIED NOV 18 1854 AGED 88 YEARS. OUT OF HIS EIGHT BROTHERS AND SISTERS. THE LARGE MARBLE STONE ALSO RECORDED THE DEATHS OF MARY JANE AUGUST 3RD 1772 AGE 10 YEARS. JOHN MAY 20TH 1783 AGED 10 - AND OF TWO INFANTS.

The public should have paid this tribute




Not far away outside in the churchyard, on the south side of the nave, is his grave, the headstone of which bears the very feint inscription:

HERE LIES THE BODY OF
GEORGE WILLIAM MANBY
BORN 1765 DIED 1854
INVENTOR OF A MORTAR FOR SAVING
LIFE IN SHIPWRECK
GRANT HIM LORD
ETERNAL REST

Above the inscription are three roundels which show a mortar, a ship and an anchor. It is in very poor condition and hardly a fitting tribute to a local hero.





Captain George William Manby FRS 1765 - 1854

So who was this man deserving two memorials in our village? George Manby was born at Easthall Manor in Denver, the son of Matthew Pepper Manby who was a captain in the Royal Welch Fusiliers. Shortly after his christening, the family moved to Wood Hall in Hilgay where the rest of his siblings were born. From the age of five, he attended a school in Downham Market where Manby claims he was educated alongside a young Horatio Nelson. This is highly unlikely as Nelson was seven when Manby was born and went to sea aged 12. In addition, Nelson's biographies record him as being educated at the Royal Grammar School in Norwich and Paston School, North Walsham with no mention of Downham Market.

At an age when today's teenagers are spending time on electronic devices, the young Manby was experimenting by shooting an attached line from a mortar over Saint Edmund's Church in Downham Market. A mortar is defined as "a simple, lightweight, man portable, muzzle-loaded weapon, consisting of a smooth-bore metal tube fixed to a base plate...launching shells in a high arcing ballistic trajectory... typically used as an indirect fire weapon for close fire support with a variety of ammunition."

After further education in Kent and failing to make the grade as an artillery officer at the Royal Military Academy, Woolwich, he became a captain in the Cambridge Militia. At the age of 28, in 1793, George was married to Jane Preston. It was a disastrous marriage leading to bankruptcy and the sale of Wood Hall. He left her in 1801 after being shot by her lover. He was bailed out of debtors prison by his younger brother, Thomas and set about writing a pamphlet on Napoleon's plans to invade England which so impressed the Secretary of War, Charles York, that he was appointed Barrack Master at Great Yarmouth.

It was while he was based In Great Yarmouth that he witnessed several shipwrecks which led to his invention of the lifesaving apparatus for which he became famous. This will be described in part two of this article.


